

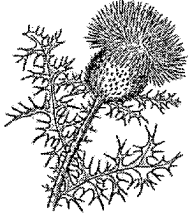

I would like to thank the learners of The Glen High School for their energy and passion that make our lives so interesting.

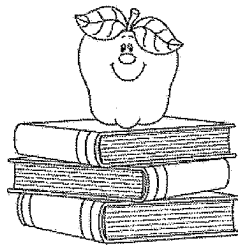
Thank you for all your work and activities throughout the year.

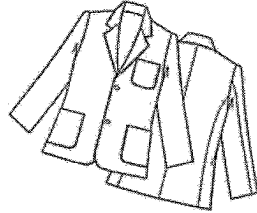
