RE: COVID-19 ALERT LEVEL 1

The SGB and the school management team of TGHS would like to thank every community member: learners, teachers, support staff, SGB and the parents for having worked together so well in COVID-19 Lockdown Risk Adjustment Alert levels five to two.

We welcome the President and the Cabinet's announcement of COVID-19 Lockdown Risk Adjustment to Alert level 1 on 16 September 2020. This will improve the social and economic activities. This does not mean that COVID-19 is no longer a health risk in our country, and particularly to our school community. The President has emphasized the need to still follow some COVID-19 protocols like to always wear face masks in public spaces, keep social distancing and regular washing of hands and/or sanitizing.
