2021 ACADEMIC RESULTS



The final Grade 8 – 11 academic results have shown that our educators and learners have worked hard to achieve their educational outcomes despite the difficulties resulting from the pandemic. Congratulations are extended to all educators and learners.

The overall pass rate for Grades 8 – 11 is 96,68 % which is a very pleasing result.

School Fees: R24 000, 00 per learner. (5% increase from 2021 fees)
 Less Pre-payment: R 2 000, 00
 Balance: R22 000, 00

POSSIBLE DISCOUNTS: (For South African citizens)

R3 600, 00 DISCOUNT IF PAID IN FULL BY 31 DECEMBER 2021.
 R2 400, 00 DISCOUNT IF PAID IN FULL BY 31 JANUARY 2022.
 R1 800, 00 DISCOUNT IF PAID IN FULL BY 28 FEBRUARY 2022.

If a debit order for 10 equal instalments is signed through our new NuPay system and all fees are paid accordingly, a DISCOUNT OF R1 200, 00 is offered. However, should one payment default, the discount will be forfeited.

Discounts are offered **per family/account** and **not** per learner.

PAYMENT OPTION 2:

10 MONTHLY PAYMENTS: **1 JANUARY** – 1 OCTOBER 2022
 R2 200, 00 after R2 000 pre-payment.

Parents are reminded that as per the signed tuition agreement between the school and parents, should a parent default on monthly school fees payments, the entire school fees balance becomes payable and is handed to debt collectors for collection. Interest and collection fees are payable on the full outstanding balance of school fees.
