## **SAPS LIAISON WITH SCHOOLS**

We are pleased to indicate that Brooklyn SAPS & CPF have been working very closely with schools in the area to network with learners and to create a learner platform for development and social investment. Two of our grade 9 learners, Jotham Mathenga and Mthokozisi Mthembu, have been elected onto the Junior Commissioner Project. Jotham has been identified as the Junior Station Commander and Mthokozisi as the Junior Visible Policing Commander. We are extremely proud of these two boys and would like to acknowledge and commend their outstanding leadership.

## **SWEDISH – SOUTH AFRICAN EXCHANGE**

We have been privileged to be selected to participate in an exchange programme between four (4) schools in Pretoria and Af Chapmanngymnasiet in Karlskrona, Sweden.

The South African schools involved are: Pretoria Technical High School, Bokgoni Technical High School, New Hope School and The Glen High School.

Eight (8) candidates from each participating South African school have been selected to be part of the exchange programme. Thirty (30) visitors from Sweden will be hosted by South African schools in February 2024, and an exchange with South African learners travelling to Sweden will take place from 15 – 22 March 2024.

Learners participating in the exchange have been selected on merit and will form collaborative relationships with their Swedish counterparts. The selected learners will be part of international discussion groups from August 2023 to March 2024 to debate UN Global Goal 1: Poverty, with the aim of establishing long-term global connections which benefit RSA.
