R1 969, 00 DISCOUNT IF PAID IN FULL BY 31 JANUARY 2024.

R1 406, 00 DISCOUNT IF PAID IN FULL BY 29 FEBRUARY 2024.

If a debit order for 10 equal instalments is signed through our new NuPay system and all fees are paid

accordingly, a DISCOUNT OF R1 406, 00 is offered. However, should one payment default, the discount will be forfeited.

Discounts are offered **per family/account** and **not** per learner.

PAYMENT OPTION 2:

10 MONTHLY PAYMENTS: 1 JANUARY – 1 OCTOBER 2023
R2 502, 30 after R3 100 pre-payment.

Parents are reminded that as per the signed tuition agreement between the school and parents, should a parent default on monthly school fees payments, **the entire school fees balance becomes payable and is handed to debt collectors for collection**. Interest and collection fees are payable on the full outstanding balance of school fees.
